#### **Visiting Legislators:**

Unless you know your elected officials very well or they have asked you to address them on a first-name basis, they should be addressed with their title followed by their last name. For Example: "Governor Reynolds," "Senator," or "Representative."

The current state of politics can lend to some contentiousness. We want to remember that this is a bipartisan event as homeschooling families represent all political leanings. To that end if you find yourself at odds with a representatives values or opinions, speak the truth in love. We want to convey kindness and grace to all those we encounter.
